What You Need To Know

So, you're interested in attending this year's Youth Revival Camp? Awesome! Last year was a blast and we believe this year will be even better! Here are the details:

Location: Highland Lakes Camp and Conference Center
5902 Pace Bend Rd N, Spicewood, TX 78669

Dates: July 8th-July 11th

Arrival and Departure: 3:00 pm Arrival to camp on July 8th
9:00 am Departure from camp on July 11th

Price: Contact your youth pastor.

Highland Lakes is packed with amenities. From high ropes and lakeside inflatables, to archery and paintball, we won't run out of fun! In order to attend, each student and adult is **REQUIRED** to fill out a registration form and submit it to their youth pastor or coordinating administrator.

Medication: Any student that takes medication is **REQUIRED** to fill out and turn in a medical administration form. True Life also has a specific protocol and requires medication to come in its ORIGINAL packaging, with an original label, and then placed inside of a Ziploc bag and labeled on the outside with a Sharpie marker the name of the medication and what the specific dosing is. Highland Lakes supplies a medical professional who will be responsible for coordinating and administering medications on time. Vitamins are included in this protocol and require a medication administration form.

Keep in mind that Highland Lakes will keep over-the-counter medications in stock and students do not need to bring these to camp.

What to Bring

- Large plastic water bottle (write your name on it with a Sharpie)
- Bible
- Notebook
- Pen/Pencils
- Sunscreen/Mosquito repellent
- 3-5 sets of activewear (think rock climbing wall, gaga ball, etc.)
- Clothes for indoor evening services
- Bathing suit (We ask that girls wear a one-piece or tankini)
- Light sweater/jacket
- Tennis shoes
- Flip flops and/or swim shoes
- Toiletries (Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant) Do NOT bring shaving cream. Highland Lakes does not allow shaving cream at their facilities.
- Towel
- Pillow, blanket and sleeping bag or sheets for twin bed
- Spending money for gift shop/snack bar if desired
- Personal snacks if you want them
- Prescriptions and over the counter medications need to be checked in with a youth leader upon arrival.

Personal Conduct & Courtesy

Highland Lakes and Youth Revival Camp prohibits the use of alcohol or tobacco in any form. Additionally, conduct unbecoming a Christian which includes disrespect, disturbance of services, immodest dress, and/or use of profanity will not be tolerated. Weapons of any kind, skateboards, and rollerblades are prohibited. Do not tamper with camp equipment. Public display of affection (PDA) is not allowed. Violence of any kind will result in being sent home and suspension from the next trip/event.

Camp Dress Policy

Let modesty be your guide when choosing clothes to pack for camp. Guys and girls are to dress appropriately at all times. If clothing is deemed inappropriate or revealing, you will be required to change. Please make sure you are wearing protective footwear at all times.

Swimming

Swimming will be at scheduled times only. Don't climb over the pool fence. When the pool is open the lifeguard has the authority to have uncooperative persons leave the swimming pool area. Do not go to the lake until directed by a leader. The lake is off limits any other time of the day or night. Both campers and youth leaders must follow all safety rules when participating in lake activities. Both girls and guys must wear T-shirts and shoes to all swimming areas. Girls are highly suggested to wear a one-piece or tankini bathing suit.

Leaving Campgrounds

Insurance prohibits anyone from leaving the camp grounds except in an emergency. Permission to leave the grounds early must be secured from the Camp Director. If you are coming late or being picked up early please have your parent contact your youth pastor so we can plan accordingly.

Schedule

Scheduled activities are not optional unless specified on the official schedule. Everyone is expected to attend the scheduled services and recreation times unless you have permission from a leader to sit out. Cabins will remain empty during all scheduled activities. Each activity starts at the printed time. Do not wait until printed time to leave your cabin. Do not return to your cabin during scheduled activities without consulting with a leader. Students are NOT allowed for any reason to be in the cabin of someone of the opposite gender or alone with anyone of the opposite gender. All students MUST be in a group of at least 3 at all times.

Camp Housing

Campers agree to pay for all damages made to any Highland Lakes property. You will be responsible to cover damages before you depart. All buildings and grounds must be left clean. Do not remove anything from the campgrounds or buildings.

Electronic Devices

Campers are ONLY allowed to bring cell phones. Leaders may confiscate electronics from students for the duration of the camp if they are becoming a distraction. Campers are responsible for their personal items.

Curfew

Lights must be out according to camp schedule unless otherwise indicated. No one is permitted outside of the cabins after lights out. This rule will be strictly enforced and any campers outside their cabin after lights out may be sent home.

Medication, Insurance, and Liability

All campers MUST have a liability and release form on file before attending camp. These forms will also be kept on file with the staff at Highland Lakes throughout the duration of camp. All medication MUST be turned into a leader. No one is allowed to keep any medication on them.

These policies have been established by Highland Lakes & Youth Revival Camp. Lack of cooperation with the camp policies may result in a camper returning home early at parent's expense. Depending upon the seriousness of the infraction, students may lose the ability to participate in future Youth Revival activities, services and/or events.
